



**VILLAGE OF BROOKLYN PLANNING COMMISSION
MINUTES
May 24, 2017**

1. Meeting was called to order by Greg Goings, Chairperson, at 6:00 p.m.
 - a. Members present: Goings, Stockton, Jenson, Powell, Akabauer, Buter (left at 6:21)
 - b. Members absent: Mickels, Lutz, Beaver
 - c. Others present: Jae Guetschow, Village Manager
2. Motion by Stockton, second by Jenson to approve the minutes for April 26, 2017. Unanimously approved by voice vote.
3. Public Comment and Communications: None.
4. Public Hearing – None
5. Discussion/Action Items
 - a. Ordinance revisions: Following review of possible ordinance language, it was moved by Stockton, seconded by Powell, to recommend a proposed amendment to ordinance sections pertaining to parking in residential districts to Village Council, to include discussed revisions. Approved 5-0-1 (Jenson abstaining) by voice vote.
 - b. Temporary sales: Discussed spring plant sales at 132 N. Main, possible food truck vendors in the C-2 district and special event sales. Consensus was that all temporary sales would require a permit.
 - c. Division 23 – Accessory buildings: Following discussion of a possible amendment to Division 23, it was moved by Jenson, seconded by Stockton, to recommend the proposed ordinance amendment to Village Council. Approved unanimously (absent Buter) by voice vote.
6. Miscellaneous Business
 - a. Master Plan revision: Stockton suggested dividing the current Comprehensive Plan among PC members to expedite the revision process. Manager Guetschow advised this would be done for the June 28, 2017 meeting.
7. Business for June 28, 2017
 - a. Master Plan revisions
 - b. Capital Improvement Plan development
 - c. Code of Ordinances revisions

8. Motion by Stockton, second by Jenson, to adjourn the meeting. Unanimously approved by voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 7:13 p.m.
